



Each day will start in Puna Ako.


You will be with a group of year 9-10 ākonga for this.

During this time you will connect with your peers and your kaiako and engage in learning activities to help support positive relationships.


On Wednesday we will have assembly for years 9-13.

Literacy

Focus is on building key skills and assessing these against the Learning Progression Framework for Reading and Writing.

Numeracy

Focus is on building key skills and assessing these against the Learning Progression Framework for Mathematics.

Health

Science

Focus is on building key skills and growing their ability to work and think like a scientist.
Gaining key skills that will help them in NCEA Level 1.

PE
